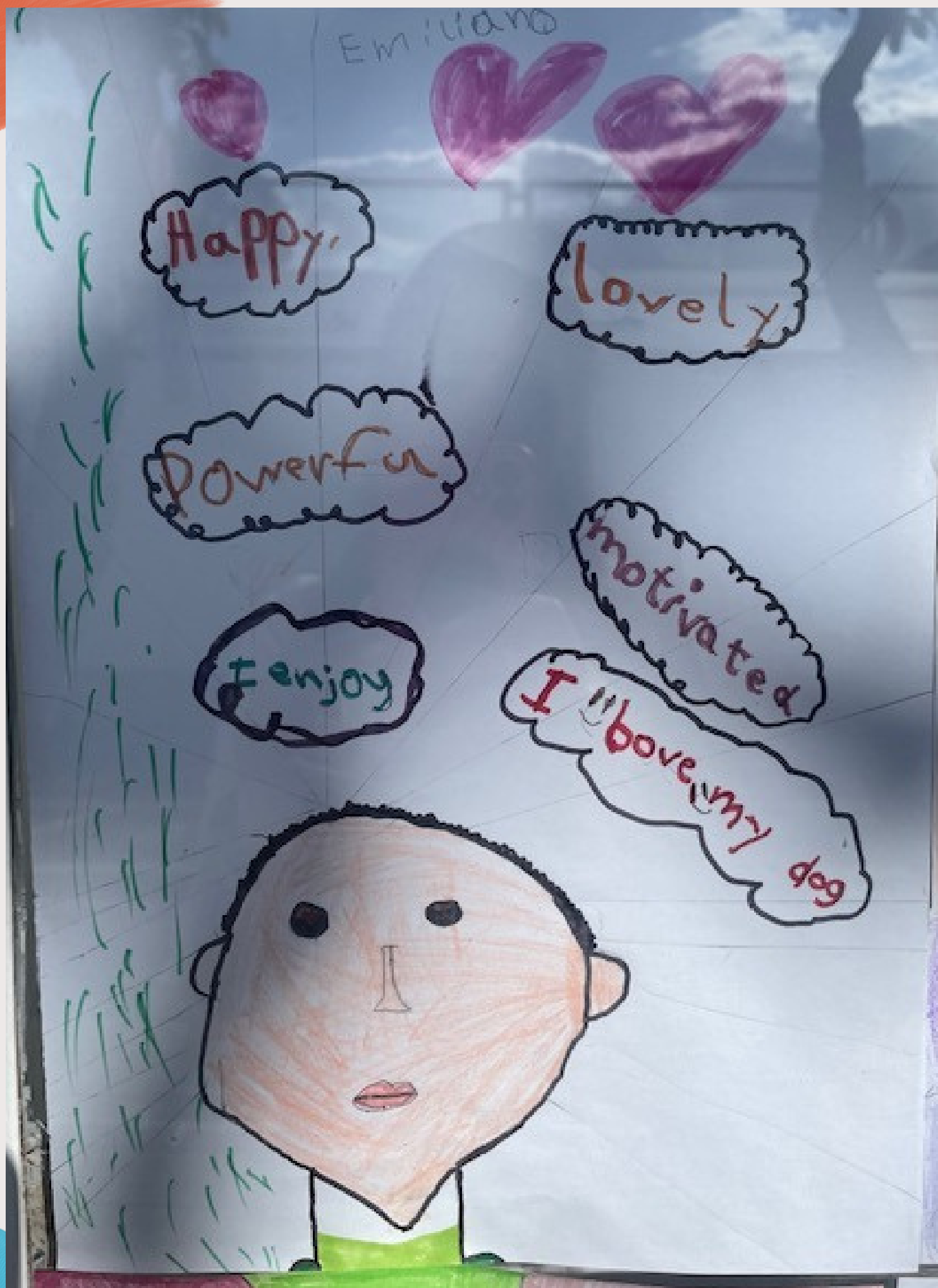
FIRST 5 DAYS IN YEAR 4!

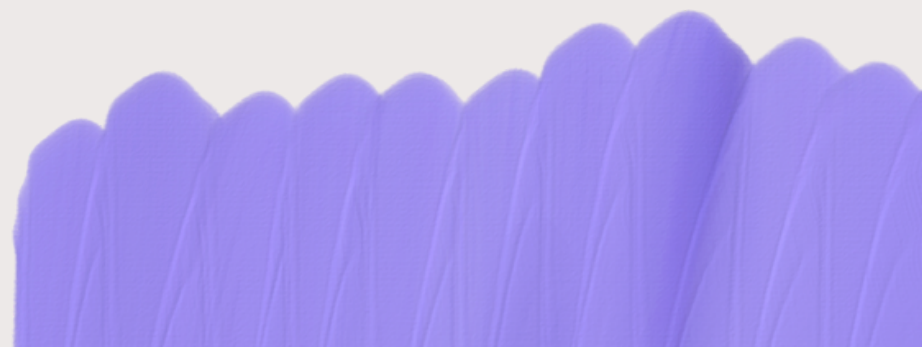


