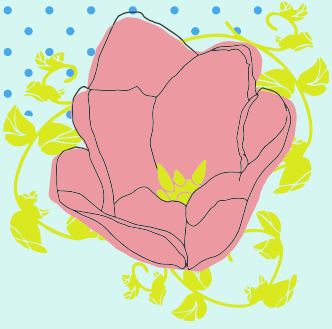

The Equality and Diversity Committee has put together these resources for YOU. We have all contributed to CLICK, therefore, you will see a little bit of us in every page.

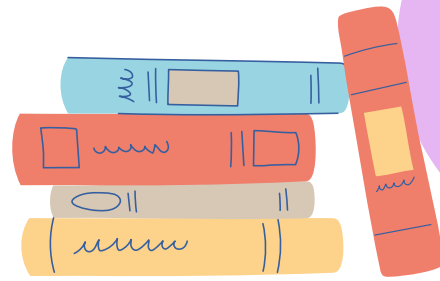
